ENTRY PROCESS

HOW TO ENTER:

Entry is free. You can enter up to four categories illustrated on pages 6 and 7. You are automatically entered into the Outstanding Excellence award. Complete the entry form on page 5 with all the relevant contact details and tick the relevant category box.

You will need to complete an entry form for each category that you are entering into. Read through the qualifying criteria on pages 6/7 for the category you are entering into and where applicable, supply the relevant information to quantify your application to ensure that all four qualifying points are covered.

You then need to answer the nine general questions that are set out on page 8. These may need to be amended for each category that you are entering into where required.

The use of graphs, charts, accounts, visuals, testimonials and any other relevant material are all encouraged where applicable.

To clarify, for each category you enter into you will need to supply the following:

- An entry form
- Supporting evidence to cover the four qualifying criteria
- Typed or hand written documentation answering the 9 general questions

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please submit as much general information as possible to assist the judges in gaining a better understanding of your business. This will also help them to measure your position against other entrants into the same category.

CRITERIA QUALIFYING INFORMATION

The organisation that best integrates social and environment activities into their culture.

- 1. Entrants, with a base in Wiltshire, will have demonstrated that their business assesses the companys' effects on environmental and social wellbeing
- 2. Entrants will need to provide a written business plan that evidences strong and sustained activity benefiting the local community or environment, going beyond that which is required by local regulators
- 3. An ethical organisation that demonstrates business growth whilst also taking responsibility for people and place, taking into account pay differentials and gender balance within the workforce
- 4. This category is open to all types of business including start-ups, locally based charities and social enterprises

CUSTOMER & STAFF CARE

The Business that puts staff and customer satisfaction at the forefront of its strategy.

A demonstration of sustained activities that help the Community.

- A depth and range of community involvement that goes beyond 1. financial support or gifts in kind
- How much time is used by staff to drive this activity and what do they achieve through this?
- 3. Detail sustained activity with community groups over time
- 4. Describe the innovation and imagination in the contribution

MEDIUM SIZED ENTERPRISE OF THE YEAR

CRITERIA QUALIFYING INFORMATION

For Businesses of £2m to £50m Annual Turnover with a sound strategy and performance.

- For businesses with turnover of £2m £50m 1.
- Entrants should demonstrate that they are well run with a strong business plan
- 3. Entrants should demonstrate growth over a 3 year period
- 4. Entrants should consider highlighting some or all of the following areas in their application:
 - Innovated marketing and sales strategies
 - Any new products or services developed over a 3 year period
 - The attractiveness of their marketplace in which they trade or operate
 - Development and commitment to their staff
 - Any other area that makes the business outstanding and worthy of this award

- 3. Provide evidence of strong and sustained relationships with customers and suppliers
- 4. Demonstrate a digital/online marketing strategy and customer engagement plans

START UP BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

CRITERIA QUALIFYING INFORMATION

Trading for less than 2 years'; the business that can show achievement and sustainability.

- Applicants should demonstrate a turnover of up to 1 million in the last financial year and have been trading for under 2 years
- 2. How was your start up achieved include a description of your product/service and the USP
- 3. Major achievements to date, including investment in your workforce
- 4. Demonstration of sustainability and strength
- 5. Future aspirations and plan for growth

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

ENTRY QUESTIONS

The judges need general information to understand your business and qualifying information to help measure your business with others entering the same category.



- In order that we can ensure eligibility criteria have been met Please enclose 3 years full audited accounts including P&L (not abbreviated). Where a company is part of a larger group then the groups turnover is the qualifying criteria. Please enclose your business plan in as much or little detail as you feel best supports your application.
- 2. Overview (500 words maximum)

This should be a short punchy paragraph to give the judges an overview describing products, services and a background to the start of your business.

- 3. Business Development Strategy (500 words maximum) Outline your development strategy for the next 3 years (new products/premises/increased turnover/more staff). Tell us about what success will look like.
- 4. Customers

Detail how you measure customer satisfaction and your customer service policy (provide testimonials where relevant).

5. Employees

How do you involve employees and maximise engagement (include evidence of responsible recruitment/ staff training).

6. Sustainability

How sustainable is your business? (Show evidence of financial planning – audited accounts can be supplied to support your entry).

- 7. Business Differentiation What additional factors make your business remarkable (community involvement, innovations etc)
- 8. Key Successes

In 500 words (maximum) describe your key successes in the last 12 months.

9. Why do you deserve to win?

In 250 words tell us why you deserve to win this Award.

RULES AND ELIGIBILITY



Entries received after that date will not be considered.
- 2. No responsibility will be accepted by the competition organisers for any material sent or any entry lost or delayed in the post. Entries will not be returned unless specifically requested and accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope.
- **3**. The winning entries will be announced at the Wiltshire Business Awards ceremony to be held at Center Parcs, Longleat Forest, Warminster BA12 7PU on 20th April 2018.
- 4. One condition of entry is that entrants co-operate with Newsquest Wiltshire, for the publication of a story about their business (whether before or after the announcement of the winners) and also with any other media coverage that may be given to their business.
